

MSJC Director doing Peace & Justice Work in So. Korea

Jim Vogt, director of the Marianist Social Justice Collaborative (MSJC), will be in So. Korea from July 7-Sept. 5 to do workshops and consulting. Jim, along with his wife Susan, will be working with the Korean group "People Creating a Circle of Peace with Justice" (PCCPJ). This group is focused particularly on promoting peace and justice within a family context. The Vogt's will spend much of their time meeting with the leadership team of PCCPJ to help them set priorities, develop effective strategies, and identify programming possibilities for the next few years. They will also lead workshops on the Pledge of Nonviolence with families whose children are attending a camp sponsored by PCCPJ, with families in two poor urban Catholic parishes in Seoul, and with volunteers working with prisoners.
